Our next school milk scheme starts on **Monday 6th January 2020**

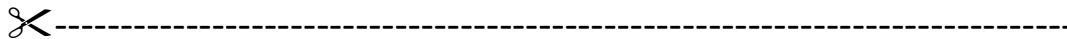

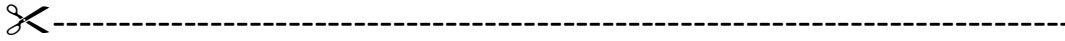
